Trustees - Stewards of the church property; supervise and maintain the property to ensure that disciple making ministries of the congregation are effective and that local legal requirements related to the property are satisfied. Finance Ministry - Provides for the financial strength of the church by ensuring the proper financial controls and reporting procedures are in place and monitored. Planned Giving Ministry - Promotes and provides education and guidance to individuals to incorporate financial giving through their estate planning. Meets as needed on Thursday afternoons. Ministry Leader: Anita Campbell (anita.campbell2468@att.net)

Nominations and Lay Leadership Ministry - Works to identify, train, nurture, and evaluate lay leaders to help them effectively carry out congregational ministries. Meets a few times annually normally from August through October. Ministry Leader: Brian Carr (bacarro072890@att.net)
